

Eskata Pre and Post Treatment Guidelines

Overview:

Eskata (hydrogen peroxide) topical solution, 40% is indicated for the treatment of seborrheic keratoses that are raised. Patients might need a second treatment about 3 weeks after the first treatment.

Pre-Treatment Guidelines:

- There are no contraindications for Eskata
- Your skin will be prepped in our office for treatment

Post Treatment Guidelines:

- Treatment area may frost (turn white) for up to 24 hours post procedure
- Most common side effects include erythema, stinging, edema, scaling, crusting and itching
- Reactions to treatment may vary among patients
- Healing time may take up to 5-7 days
- Do not apply any skin care products to the treatment area for 24 hours
- After 24 hours, you may apply Aquaphor or Vasaline to the treatment site to help with the healing process
- Keep the area covered with sunscreen throughout the healing process
